

PUBLIC NOTICE

AGENCY: Federal Aviation Administration, DOT

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is reviewing a draft Environmental Assessment (EA) for potential environmental impacts related to the proposed **New Corporate Taxilane and Corporate Hangars** at the **Pitt-Greenville Airport, Greenville, North Carolina**.

The project includes construction of a new hangar taxilane, paved access road to the existing fuel farm, and a hangar access road; demolition and clearing; relocation of the existing airport rotating beacon; site grading and drainage for up to three future hangars and perimeter fencing. The project area is 7.5 acres on airport property at the southwest corner of Airport Road and Memorial Drive.

The draft EA will be available for review for a period of 30 days from the publication of this notice. The draft EA may be reviewed on the airport's website, www.flypgv.com, and at the following locations:

A **public information workshop** regarding the project and the draft EA will be held in the Airport Terminal building, first floor, 400 Airport Road, Greenville, NC, on **September 19, 2018** from 5:00 to 6:00 PM.
