Subject: Pitt Greenville Airport Receives \$3,406,185 FAA Grant to Rehabilitate and Expand General Aviation Apron

The Pitt Greenville Airport Authority is excited to announce the Federal Aviation Administration has awarded \$3,406,185 to fund rehabilitation and expansion of the General Aviation Apron. This will fund 90% of the \$3,784,650 cost of the project with the Pitt Greenville Airport funding the other \$378,465. This project is needed to relieve some of the congestion experienced on the General Aviation parking apron, to reconstruct pavement that is in need of upgrades and enhance safety and efficiency by bringing the apron design up to new FAA standards.

“Pitt Greenville Airport is thankful for the FAA’s continued support”, says Bill Hopper, Pitt Greenville Airport Executive Director. “This will allow us to provide the best services possible to our general aviation community and enhance the safety and efficiency of our overall operations.”
