UPCOMING PROJECTS

FAA CERTIFICATION INSPECTION

The FAA will be onsite this July to conduct its annual certification inspection of PGV. The FAA inspector will be onsite for approximately two days and do a day inspection, a night inspection, an inspection of training records, and also evaluate the airport's responses for aircraft emergencies. This is probably the busiest two-days every year for the airport's operations and maintenance staff.



PITT-GREENVILLE AIRPORT

NORTH 24 UPDATE

This project expands the airport's footprint for further aeronautical development. It is a 24-acre grass site north of Runway 8/26 and east of Runway 2/20. There is no space to build hangars or other aeronautical structures in the present footprint and when completed, the North 24 will be a shovel ready site for this type of development. When complete, there will be a paved taxilane connecting the North 24 to Taxiway A, an access road from Old Belvoir Highway, and utilities will be provided to the area. The Airport's consulting engineer, McFarland Johnson, Inc., is presently doing required environmental work in the area and preparing design plans and specifications to move toward the construction phase. The project is estimated at \$4,000,000 and will be funded approximately 50%/ 50% by each FAA and NCDOT, Aviation. Construction is anticipated to begin early 2026 and completed summer, 2026.

UPCOMING PROJECTS CONTINUED




The FAA will fund 95% and NCDOT, Aviation will fund 5% of a \$1.3M project to replace perimeter fence in two sections. This is the first phase of what will be a \$3M perimeter fence and perimeter road replacement. It will enhance security and wildlife control. The present six foot high fence will be replaced with an eight foot high fence with features designed to prevent entry of wildlife to the airfield. The remaining \$1.7M will be done in 2027.



RUNWAY 8/26

The airport has applied for an FAA grant in the amount of approximately \$600,000 to rehabilitate Runway 8/26. The grant will cover 95% of the funds needed for the design phase and will be done by McFarland Johnson. The other 5% will be funded by NCDOT, Aviation. The grant is anticipated for award this summer. Construction is approximately \$6.5M and is anticipated to take place early 2027. The runway width will be reduced to 75-feet when completed. The airport has been working with the FAA for over six years to fund the project and it is finally coming to fruition!


