KATHERINE SUI FUN CHEUNG

FIRST FEMALE ASIAN-AMERICAN AVIATOR



Katherine Sui Fun Cheung was a well-known stunt flier in the 1930s. Her heart belonged to the sky and she boldly challenged the societal norm for Asian and Asian-American women to be quiet and keeping the house in order, and instead became a pilot. As if she was born with wings, she flew solo after only twelve hours of lessons.

Cheung performed spiral dives, barrel rolls, acrobatic loops, and more. She was inducted into the Aviation Hall of Fame and the Museum of Flying's International Women in Aviation Pioneer Hall of Fame. In China, she is known as "China's Amelia Earhart" and has a place in the Beijing Air Force Aviation Museum. Amelia Earhart herself also invited Cheung into her Ninety-Nines club for women pilots.

Church had a dream to fly as a career and pursued the Boeing Air Transport Office. Unfortunately, they only hired male pilots.

Church elevated her skills as a nurse to convince them to hire her as a stewardess for added safety. On May 15, 1930, Church became the world's first stewardess.
